Item Title: Mayor Ben Cahoon – Discussion of legislation re: digging holes on the beach
Consideration of resolution

Item Summary:

At the June 1, 2022 Board meeting, Comr. Renee Cahoon expressed concerns about large dangerous holes being left unfilled on the beach and the limited enforcement mechanisms available to towns to deal with this issue. The Board supported taking the issue of large beach holes to state-wide coastal communities for endorsement of local legislation that would give coastal towns additional means to enforce the issue.

Recently, Mayor Cahoon contacted other coastal towns to gauge their interest. Positive responses were received from several Crystal Coast towns and most Outer Banks towns. Once formal support is obtained from the coastal towns, an official request will be submitted to the legislature to support our request.

At the August 3rd Board of Commissioners meeting, Mayor Ben Cahoon will present a resolution in support of legislation concerning digging holes on the beach. This resolution will also be shared with other coastal communities for their formal support.
