



**TOWN OF NAGS HEAD
BOC ACTIONS
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 20, 2024**

- 1.** Call to order - Mayor Cahoon called the meeting to order at 9 a.m. A moment of silence acknowledging the passing of former Town employee, Robert "Murph" Isaacs, Jr., was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 2.** Agenda – The Board approved the March 20th agenda as presented. Mayor Pro tem Siers was not present and excused.
- 3.** Public Comment – Susie Walters; Nags Head resident; she requested that the Board re-analyze their strategic goals, the adopted and approved land-use plan, and the community expectations to budget and subsidize the Town recycling service.
- 4.** Public Comment - Mayor Cahoon acknowledged email comments from Nags Head residents Diane Wehner and Mike Anzalone regarding the subscription recycling service.
- 5.** Consideration of revised Residential Recycling Contract and Town subsidy– The Board approved the contract as recommended by staff including the increase of the monthly subsidy from \$5.00 to \$6.50 a month.
- 6.** Comr. Brinkley - complemented the recent NHPD social media campaign regarding stopping at red lights and the additional enforcement by our officers.
- 7.** Mayor Cahoon – Echoed Comr. Brinkley’s comment complementing NHPD and that regarding the Ban Balloon Releases in NC proposal that was presented during the March 6, 2024, public comment period, he would like to see the Town consider the possibility of banning balloon releases from Town Property and public beaches as a first step. Comr. Brinkley recommended handling through crowd gathering permit process.
- 8.** Closed/Open Session – The Board entered Closed Session at 09:20 a.m. to discuss the possible acquisition of real property, 4222 S Croatan Hwy, Nags Head, in accordance with GS 143-318.11(a)(5) – and re-entered Open Session at 10:24 a.m.
- 9.** Adjournment - The Board adjourned at 10:25 a.m.
