

## RESOLUTION TO WAIVE PERMIT FEES ASSOCIATED WITH WINTER STORM RILEY

**WHEREAS**, During the weekend of March 2 - 4, 2018, Winter Storm Riley hit the Outer Banks with strong winds, sound, and eventual ocean overwash; AND

**WHEREAS**, Storm surge conditions caused major flooding in already-saturated areas in the Town of Nags Head; AND

**WHEREAS**, Extreme overwash and strong winds caused property damage to a number of residences and businesses throughout the Town; AND

**WHEREAS**, Repairs to damaged structures and reconstruction efforts will require permits along with the associated reviews and inspections in accordance with Town Code Chapter 10 (Buildings and Building Regulations) and Chapter 48 (Zoning), AND

**WHEREAS**, Property owners are normally responsible for paying the permit fees associated with their home repairs and reconstruction projects; AND

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Nags Head wants to work with property owners to assist them in making the necessary repairs to their properties as quickly and as easily as possible.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town of Nags Head Board of Commissioners does hereby waive permit fees for the repair or reconstruction of structures that were damaged during the recent Winter Storm Riley.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the waiver of permit fees associated with the impacts of Winter Storm Riley is effective March 7, 2018 and will expire April 7, 2018.
