



**RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO HOUSE BILL 330
CIVPRO/QUALIFIED IMMUNITY FOR AUTO ACCIDENT**

WHEREAS, House Bill 330 is entitled: *An Act Providing That A Person Driving An Automobile While Exercising Due Care Is Immune From Civil Liability For Any Injury To Another If the Injured Person Was Participating In A Protest Or Demonstration And Blocking Traffic In A Public Street Or Highway At The Time Of The Injury*; AND

WHEREAS, North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper has proclaimed his opposition to House Bill 330 by requesting that the North Carolina legislature defeat a bill that grants immunity for certain automobile drivers during protests or demonstrations from civil liability who strike and/or attack protesters, using their vehicles as a weapon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Nags Head Board of Commissioners does hereby oppose House Bill 330 and supports Governor Roy Cooper in his efforts.
