



AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION BY GOVERNING BODY OF THE APPLICANT

Building Reuse Grants Program – Rural Health Care

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Rural Infrastructure Authority (RIA) has authorized the awarding of grants from appropriated funds to aid eligible units of government in financing the cost of building activities needed to create jobs; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Nags Head needs assistance in financing a building project that may qualify for Rural Grants/Programs funding; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Nags Head intends to request grant assistance for Peak Resources Nursing and Rehabilitation Renovation Facility, 430 Health Center Drive, project from the Building Reuse Grant Program – Rural Health Care Category.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS:

That the Town of Nags Head will provide 5% of the Building Reuse Program Grant toward project construction costs, if approved for a grant with Peak Resources Inc. providing the match.

That Robert C. Edwards, Mayor and successors so titled, is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the Town of Nags Head with the Rural Grants/Programs Section for a grant to assist in the above-named Building Reuse project.

That Cliff Ogburn, Manager, and successors so titled, is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as Rural Grants/Programs Section may request in connection with an application or with the project proposed; to make assurances as contained in the application; and to execute such other documents as may be required in connection with the application.

That the Town of Nags Head has substantially complied or will substantially comply with all federal, state, and local laws, rules, regulations, and ordinances applicable to the project and to the grants pertaining thereto.
