**RESOLUTION REQUESTING NCDOT TAKE ACTION TO MITIGATE
FLOODING SAFETY HAZARDS IN THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD**

WHEREAS, The Town of Nags Head experiences severe flooding situations in South Nags Head on South Old Oregon Inlet Road (SR 1243) during periods of steady rain and throughout the Town on NC 12 (Beach Road) as well as in the west side neighborhoods such as Vista Colony, Nags Head Acres, and Northridge Subdivisions; AND

WHEREAS, Several weeks after Hurricane Sandy in October 2012, flooding on South Oregon Inlet Road (SR 1243) was still present producing hazardous conditions resulting in a tremendous overflow of water on the multi-use path requiring users of the multi-use path (walkers, joggers, bicyclists, etc.) to use the roadway; AND

WHEREAS, When users of the multi-use path in South Nags Head utilize the roadway (SR 1243) due to flooding on the path, they are exposed to vehicles coming from both directions that are driving through standing water – all share one lane of the two-lane roadway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Nags Head Board of Commissioners hereby requests that the North Carolina Department of Transportation, in order to promote and protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public, work with Town officials to improve the flooding situation on South Old Oregon Inlet Road (SR 1243) and to continue to address stormwater issues throughout the Town.
