



**RESOLUTION - REQUEST FOR REDUCED SPEED ON SR 1243
(SOUTH OLD OREGON INLET ROAD)
IN VICINITY OF OUTER BANKS FISHING PIER**

WHEREAS, the Outer Banks Fishing Pier hosts a popular bar/grille, Fish Heads, which attracts many customers on a daily basis that often exceed the vehicle parking capacity of the Pier's parking lot; AND

WHEREAS, at the August 7, 2013 Board of Commissioners meeting, the Board adopted an ordinance modifying the Traffic Control Map prohibiting parking on the west side of SR 1243 - 80' north and south of the Isabella Street Beach Access (located directly north of the Outer Banks Fishing Pier); AND

WHEREAS, lowering the speed limit from 45 MPH in the area of Outer Banks Fishing Pier was also discussed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Town of Nags Head Board of Commissioners, meeting in recessed session on September 18, 2013 respectfully requests that the NC Department of Transportation reduce the speed limit on S Old Oregon Inlet Road from 45 MPH to 35 MPH in the vicinity of Outer Banks Fishing Pier for the safety of pedestrians and vehicles who travel to the Pier.
