



**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD, NORTH CAROLINA
ADOPTING THE DARE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL
HAZARD MITGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, on October 30, 2000, the President of the United States signed into law the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 to amend the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of 1988 to reinforce the importance of pre-disaster mitigation planning to help reduce disaster losses; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina Senate Bill 300 requires all local governments to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan in order to receive state public assistance funds (effective for state-declared disasters after November 1, 2004); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Nags Head Hazard Mitigation Plan was approved on August 4, 2004 by the Nags Head Board of Commissioners and subsequently approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the North Carolina Division of Emergency Management (NCEM); and


WHEREAS, the Town of Nags Head, in accordance with guidance provided by FEMA, NCEM, and the County of Dare, passed a resolution to merge said Plan with the County of Dare on October 7, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 3rd day of November 2010 that the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Nags Head hereby adopts the Dare County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.
