



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
OF THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD, NORTH CAROLINA**

PART I. That **Section 26.2.1 Fireworks and pyrotechnic displays unlawful; exceptions.** Paragraph (a) be amended as follows:

Except as otherwise provided in this section it shall be unlawful for any person to use, ignite, launch, or explode any firecracker, torpedo, sky rocket, sparkler, wish lantern, sky lantern, or other substance or device that contains any explosive or flammable compound or substance, or which is ignited and then released from the manual control of the user, including but not limited to items and is intended or commonly known or intended as fireworks, and which explodes, rises into the air or travels laterally, fires projectiles or discharges sparks into the air, or floats while or after having been ignited.

PART II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the **15<sup>th</sup> day of May 2013.**


