



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
OF THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD, NORTH CAROLINA**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Nags Head, North Carolina, that the Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

PART I. That **Section 48-842, Regulations governing signage within the Village at Nags Head**, be amended as follows:

**Sec. 48-842(f)(2), Tract Identification Signs for Class 2, Community Subdivisions.**

- (2) *Class 2, community subdivision.*
- a. One identification sign along U.S. Highway 158 is permitted for major entrances to the western area.
  - b. The area of copy for each identification sign for major entrances may not exceed 30 square feet.
  - c. No extremity of a sign structure used to support or decorate community identification signs shall exceed an area of 300 square feet.
  - d. The height of the community sign shall not exceed eight feet.

PART II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the 5th day of May 2010.
